

ORDINANCE NO. 957

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOLLISTER
AMENDING CHAPTER 12.36 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO
PARADES AND PUBLIC ASSEMBLIES, AND CHAPTER 9.04 RELATING
TO PUBLIC PEACE AND DECENCY**

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOLLISTER ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Chapter 12.36 amended. Chapter 12.36 of the Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding new section 12.36.195, and amending sections 12.36.200 and 12.36.210, with the added language *so indicated*, and the deleted language ~~so indicated~~, to read in their entirety as follows:

“Section 12.36.195 Animals prohibited. *No dogs or animals of any kind shall be allowed on any public street, sidewalk, or other property owned or controlled by the city during a parade or public assembly for which a permit has been issued by the city, except when such animal is authorized by permit to participate in the event.”*

“Section 12.36.200 Violations. In addition to any other conduct or activity specifically prohibited by this chapter or city ordinance, it shall be a violation of this chapter for any person to:

1. Physically obstruct, impede, hamper or otherwise interfere with any event authorized by a permit, or with any participant in such event.
2. Drive a vehicle between vehicles or persons traversing the route of a parade authorized by a permit when such vehicles or persons are in motion.
3. *Walk, remain, stop, or park along or within any portion of the route or site of an event authorized by a permit, when the route or site has been lawfully cordoned off or posted. ~~by the chief of police in the manner authorized by this chapter.~~*
4. Sell tickets, or offer to sell tickets, to an event without first obtaining a permit *therefor.*
5. Operate, conduct, or participate in an event *in violation of any provision of this chapter or city ordinance, or in such a manner as to create a public or private nuisance.*
6. Consume, sell, or be in possession of intoxicating liquor at an event, or knowingly allow any person to do so, except where such consumption or possession is expressly authorized by the terms of the permit ~~and state law or regulation of the activity is preempted by state law.~~
7. Knowingly allow any person attending an event to use, sell, or be in possession of any dangerous or illegal drug.”

“Section 12.36.210 Penalties. Violations of this chapter shall be subject to the general penalty provisions of the Municipal Code.” ~~Chapter 1A~~

Section 2. Chapter 9.04 amended. Chapter 9.04 of the Municipal Code relating to offenses against public peace and decency is hereby amended by adding new section 9.04.050, entitled “Public Urination” to read in its entirety as follows:

“Section 9.04.050 Public urination. It is unlawful for any person to urinate in a public place other than a restroom, or in a place open to public view, or upon the private property of another without the consent of the owner or person in lawful possession.”

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days from and after its final passage.

Section 4. Publication. Within fifteen (15) days after passage, the City Clerk shall cause this ordinance to be published one time in the Free Lance, a newspaper of general circulation.


